Billy Gordon MP to remain in Queensland Parliament as an Independent

The Member for Cook, Billy Gordon MP, who recently resigned from the Labor Party, has announced that he intends to remain as an Independent Member in the Queensland Parliament.

Mr Gordon recently resigned from the ALP following media reports of allegations relating to his personal life.

He will now sit on the cross bench with Katter's Australia Party MPs, Rob Katter and Shane Knuth, but will continue to give confidence to the Palaszczuk Government.

The confidence motion, which passed 44 votes to 42 last month in Queensland Parliament's first sitting week, still stands.
