

New NSW Opposition Leader

On 23 December 2014 the Hon John Robertson MP resigned as NSW Opposition Leader.

On 5 January 2015 Luke Foley MLC was elected unopposed as NSW Opposition Leader by the Labor Caucus.

Mr Foley is presently a member of the Legislative Council and will be seeking to move to the Legislative Assembly at the next NSW state election, to be held on 28 March 2015.

Mr Foley has announced his intention to seek preselection in the electorate of Auburn in western Sydney. A preselection vote is due to be held later in January.

The Hon Linda Burney MP will remain as Deputy Opposition Leader.

An updated Shadow Ministry will be announced in the coming days. Mr Foley has indicated his intention to retain the Infrastructure portfolio.
