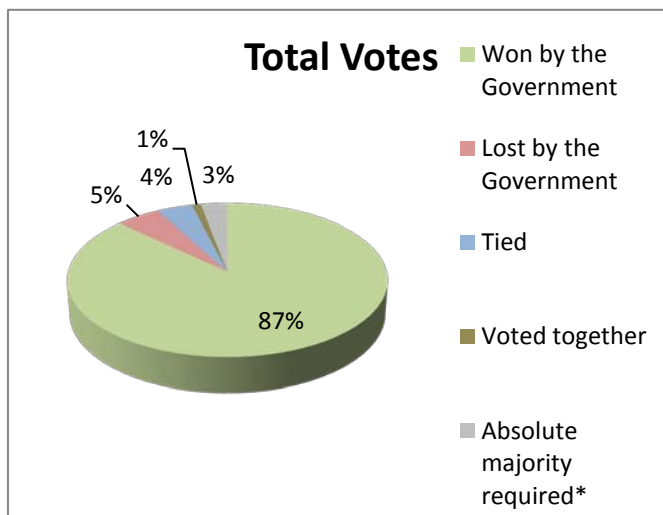
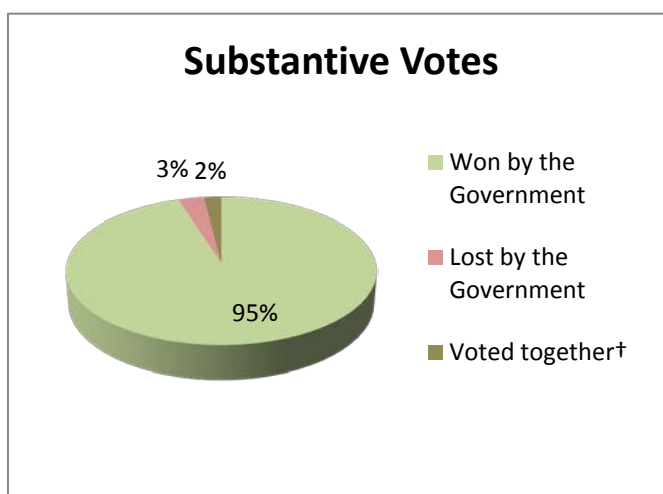


Voting records from the House of the 43<sup>rd</sup> Parliament – from 29/9/10 to 24/3/11

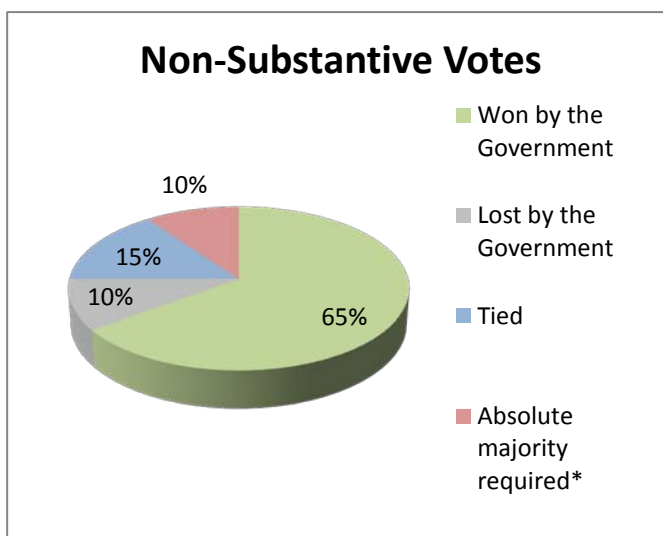
<b>Total Number of Votes:</b>	<b>79</b>
