

Premier Anastacia Palaszczuk today announced her new Ministerial Cabinet following the resignation of Deputy Premier and Treasurer, Jackie Trad MP.

Minister Steven Miles MP will now be Queensland's Deputy Premier and continue in his role as Minister for Health and Minister Ambulance Services.

Minister Cameron Dick MP will assume the role of Treasurer and retain half of his previous portfolio as Minister for Infrastructure and Planning.

Minister Kate Jones MP will now be responsible for State Development along with her current portfolios of Tourism, Innovation and Cross River Rail.

Jackie Trad MP will recontest the electorate of South Brisbane at the Queensland State Election on 31 October.
