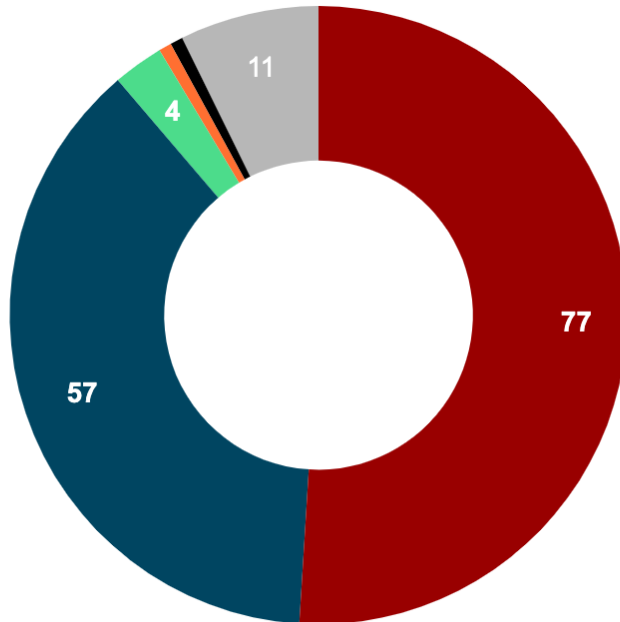


The current composition of the Australian Parliament (as of 06/02/2023)

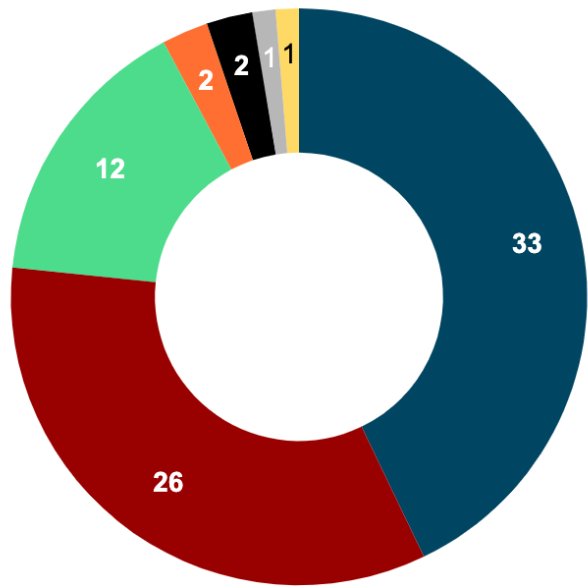

- Senator Jim Molan AO DSC died on 16 January 2023. The identity of the new NSW Liberal Senator to fill the resulting “casual vacancy” is expected to be confirmed following the NSW State election scheduled for 25 March 2023. As the NSW Parliament is not expected to sit prior to then, the seat will likely remain vacant throughout the Autumn Sittings (February-March 2023). Where relevant, the Government is expected to grant a “pair”, meaning the balance of votes within the Senate will not change.
